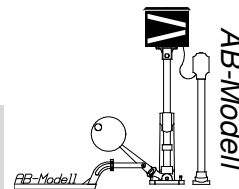


# Swiss narrow gauge – Rhaetian Railway



RhB – Sliding door wagon Haik-v 5121 – 5125 „Valser“



## Prototype:

In 1970 RhB started with its first four-axled sliding-door-wagons. They could be loaded by machines, which was much quicker and efficient, than the former two-axled wagons.

In 1980 the company bought further 25 vehicles. Five of them were used for advertising "Valser".

The Haik-v 5121 - 5125 were set in motion in 1980. The capacity is at 26,0t. The wagon has a white painting with "Valser"-sign on it.

RhB uses the wagons for the transport of mineral water from Ilanz to Untervaz. Complete trains of six or more wagons could be seen in the Rhine-gorge. Even ancient HGe4/4 from FO has been lended for these transports.
