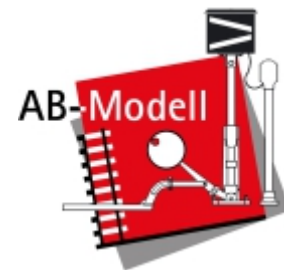


Information from Fairs

There is no need to introduce the N-Tram company to model railway enthusiasts with an affinity for fine handcrafted models in N and Nm.

In addition to his finely designed miniature dioramas, Wolfgang Besenhart had exhibited current novelties in a showcase.

There were a total of 4 different variants of the Ge2/4 of the Rhaetian Railway on display.

Among the freight wagons, the cement silo wagon Uce 8063-8066 is being delivered, also available in the original labelling as OB.

An open observation car, based on a type Kkl freight car, completes the new items programme.

There were also the type L high-sided wagons in grey, later designated as Ek in brown, as well as the K³ boxcars in grey and brown to be seen.

The Bernina two-axle carriages in green and green-ivory will follow in a very small quantity.

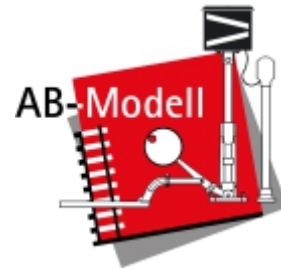

During the four days of the exhibition, we presented our new products of the current year, which you already know from previous newsletters.

RhB: Ge4/4III 644 - world record locomotive,
Tmf2/2 85 - orange shunting tractor,
Tm2/2 92 - yellow service tractor,
Lb-v and Sb-v - two- and four-axle carrier wagons with Coop Edellieschen and Holcim tank containers,
Rolling stool with split and continuous wheel chock bar, loaded with N wagons and unloaded.
FO: D4341 - four-axle baggage car.
MOB: Ge8002 - express train locomotive and matching EW I in the current Regio look pearl white/night blue.
MTGN: Beh2/4 203 - cogwheel railcar.

We also had our full-scale diorama 'Filisur in the 1990s' with us and daily changing train compositions from the 1970s to the end of the 1990s on display.

There is obviously substantial progress to report on the Arosa Express. On display were the driving trailer Bt 1703 (PI-9215.N/Nm), the luggage coach BD 2481 (PI-9212.N/Nm), and the first class coach As 1256 (PI-9211.N/Nm), in raw body form, without printing.

The Ge4/4II 610ff. with round headlights in a green colour scheme, based on the well-known Kato chassis, was presented as a new model.

The Pirata models can be pre-ordered. Prices and delivery dates are not yet known and will be announced by newsletter. If economically and technically feasible, gauge changes will be carried out by Meterspur-Schweiz.
