the year 2024 is drawing to a close and we would like to thank all our customers for their lovalty and patience.


At the same time, we would like to take this opportunity to inform you about important changes in the distribution of our products.

We have been building models for over 40 years, now in our 28th year under the AB-Modell company label. We have not grown any younger during this time, although the hobby keeps us young. With a great deal of commitment, we have added numerous products to our programme, which are increasingly costing us time and energy. We have therefore decided to give up the sale of 1:150 scale models and accessories. Of course, this will not happen overnight, but will be a gradual process in 2025.

Details on the individual product areas are listed below.

With this measure, we hope to be able to normalise the now almost endless delivery times for our handcrafted models, which are not affected by the restructuring. We thank you for your understanding and wish you a Merry Christmas.

Kato

Kato has been active in the Swiss narrow-gauge railway market since 2013 and surprised everyone at the time with the Glacier Express starter set. The Japanese scale of 1:150, which is rather unusual for us continental Europeans, was only briefly a topic of conversation and is now well established, as the sales figures for Kato models show. At the games fair and N-Convention in Stuttgart in November, we were able to speak to the German representative Yurija Nakahara. Kato is planning great locomotive and wagon novelties for next year. You can look forward to it!

Existing Orders

Orders that we have confirmed to you will be delivered next year as soon as we receive the models. These are primarily the models originally announced for autumn 2024, which are now expected in early 2025.

New Orders

We are no longer accepting new orders for Kato material. This does not apply to rolling stock and spare parts that we still have in stock. Please take a look at our price list at www.n-schmalspur.de where we list all currently available vehicles. Only while stocks last.

The Kato models are available from your model railway dealer or from the new German representative Lemke at www.lemkecollection.de. Products that can be pre-ordered are also listed there.

MDS

In 2017, the company MDS announced its own 1:150 models, including the frequently requested Ge4/4II and the attractive sliding wall wagons. The numerous advertising models have now become popular collector's items and are in great demand.

Unfortunately, we were unable to meet Gunnar Müller in Stuttgart, but he has already told us by telephone that further special series of his vehicles are planned.

Existing Orders

We have delivered almost all of the orders confirmed to you.

We are no longer accepting new orders for MDS material. The stock has been reduced to a few sliding wall wagons and two locomotives. You can still find available models in our price list at www.n-schmalspur.de.

MDS N-Narrow Gauge

Unfortunately, the attractive Ge4/4II is not available as an Nm model.

You can easily re-gauge the goods wagons yourself:

- Pull the bogie downwards,
- remove the axles from the bearings,
- press our replacement axles into the axle bearings,
- reinsert the bogie.

That's it! No milling work is necessary.

Replacement axles can still be ordered from us and are available as long as stocks last. It has not yet been clarified whether fully regauged models will be available from www.meterspur-schweiz.com at a later date.

MDS N-Gauge

In addition to its own webshop, MDS has also published a list of dealers on its website www.mds-modell.eu, where you can also purchase the N models.

Pirata

In 2018, Pirata launched the first 1:150 scale models with the stake wagons made of etched brass supplemented with 3D printed parts. In addition, repaints and conversions based on the Kato rolling stock appear frequently.

Some of the numerous announcements date back to 2020, but it is not known when they will be delivered. In addition, new model variations that had not previously been announced often appear.

We spoke to Stefano Ramunno in Stuttgart. A new magnetic coupling is also available for Kato wagons, among others. The green Ge4/4II with round headlights and two advertising locomotives based on the Ge4/4III were also on display

(Watson, RhB locomotive with large sidewall advertising). The announced Arosa wagons stood in the display case as unpainted 3D-printed hand samples.

We will try to deliver the open orders in 2025, if available through Pirata.

We reserve the right to cancel models that will not be available in the foreseeable future. We will of course inform you of any changes to your vehicle order by e-mail.

New Orders



Nm-Small Series Models

Our handcrafted models for the Nm gauge are not affected by the above-mentioned changes, i.e. we will concentrate on the production of these models in future and hope to normalise the delivery times, which have got out of hand in the meantime. We would like to take this opportunity to thank all our customers once again for their patience.

Nevertheless, we are also planning some changes in this model segment, some of which have already been implemented. In principle, we will not follow up one series with another. So if a model is sold out, it will remain so. Exceptions are vehicles for which we can offer a different livery or labelling. These are shown in our price list as 'new edition under review'.

The series are limited. Please order your desired model in good time before it is marked as sold out!

If you purchase kits that are still available on the market, please bear in mind that we cannot build such models to order! We do not have the necessary capacity for this. Thank you for your understanding.
